

# Cops quiz victims of botox doc

## Patients of disgraced surgeon are urged to get medical help

POLICE have started to question victims of a bogus plastic surgeon believed to have butchered victims in Dubai.

One of disgraced doctor Steven Moos' patients, who was left with lumpy lips after a botched botox job, told 7DAYS police have been in touch and are eager to gather evidence against the international fugitive.

The woman said: "The police have been in touch and I am going in to speak to CID. There were other people worse affected than me so I assume they'll be questioning others to try and get this guy convicted."

Former patients are also being urged to seek medical advice if they are

concerned about their health following run-ins with the rogue doctor.

Dr Dawood Sulaiman, from Dubai's International Aesthetic Medical Centre, said those treated by Moos should not to suffer in silence.

He said: "If people were treated by this man and they have concerns, they should go to a reputable plastic surgeon and ask for some advice."

Moos has been charged with endangering patients' lives, impersonating a physician and carrying out unlicensed activities. He remains in police custody.
